How REACH ABH Works

3-Day Virtual Training:

Start by joining us virtually from **March 21 - 23, 2025**. In these 3 days, you will engage with expert faculty and peers in interactive sessions that equip you with the skills to assess, manage, and treat adult mental health and substance use concerns in a primary care setting.

Bi-Monthly Case-Based Learning Calls:

In the four months that follow this training, you will join twice-monthly calls where participants take turns presenting real cases from their practice. You'll share your approach, then receive feedback and coaching from your peers and REACH faculty.

- ▶ Correctly identify and differentiate between common adult mental health and substance use issues
- ▶ Create and implement a comprehensive and effective treatment plan
- ▶ Integrate mental health and substance use care into your everyday practice
- ▶ Effectively manage psychopharmacology
